


DEPLOY TAB UTILIZATION

The “Deploy” tab in MRRS is used to indicate the assignment of Marines and Sailors (Individual Augmentee, unit/detachment deployments, TDY, etc.) to operational areas that require the Deployment Related Health Assessments (DRHAs). It is also used when the Combatant Commander, Service component commander or commander exercising operational control requires DRHAs. Refer to DODI 6490.03 for more information.

Deployed/Deploying: Set the member’s “Deployed/Deploying” status to “Yes” no earlier than 120 days prior to the start of the assignment/deployment that will require the Deployment Related Health Assessments (DRHA). Click the  icon next to the Deployed/Deploying drop down window to download a copy of this guide.

Theater Entry Date: Enter the date that the member is expected to arrive in the theater of deployment.

Estimated Theater Departure Date: Enter the date that the member is expected to return. 30 days prior to this date the member will become due for the Post Deployment Health Assessment (PDHA) (DD2796) and remain due until becoming overdue 30 days after this date. This date may be modified at any time when order modifications or extensions occur. If a PDHA is not completed, this date will be used to determine the 90-180 day window for when the Post Deployment Health Re-Assessment (PDHRA) (DD2900) is due.

Destination COCOM: From the dropdown, select the COCOM Area of Responsibility (AOR) that the member will be assigned to. This action will trigger the required immunizations for the specific AOR. For additional information, click the AOR link to the right of the Destination COCOM window.

Country: From the dropdown, select the country that the member will be assigned to.

DHA Reason: From the dropdown, select the reason the DHA is required. In most cases this will be >30 days Outside of the United States or Command Directed.

Event: From the dropdown, select the type of event associated with the Service member’s deployment.

MRRS OPERATION:

When the Estimated Theater Departure Date has passed, the system assumes the member has returned from the assignment and the Deployed/Deploying status will turn from “Yes” to “No” and the deployment data will move from Active Deployment to Deployment History. Automatic refinement of the end of the member’s deployment is done by using the Departure from Theater Date provided by the member when the PDHA (DD2796) is received. If a completed PDHA is received prior to the Estimated Theater Departure Date the Departure from Theater Date will overwrite the Estimated Theater Departure Date and become the new date for calculating when the PDHRA (DD2900) is due and will set the Deployed/Deploying status to No.

Note: Manual entry of DRHA completion is not required and strongly discouraged as only DRHAs electronically submitted and certified by a health care provider via eDHA and transferred to the DoD repository are considered complete. The automated process of eDHA electronically updating MRRS in 3 to 5 working days ensures only properly completed DRHAs are recorded in MRRS.
