

INDIVIDUAL DISCRIMINATION COMPLAINT PROCESS

An employee, former employee, or applicant for employment who feel they have been discriminated against because of Race, Color, Religion, Sex, National Origin, Age (40 years of age & over), Physical or Mental disability, Genetic Information, Gender Stereotyping, Pregnancy or Reprisal for Prior EEO involvement may file a complaint by contacting an EEO counselor within 45 calendar days following the alleged discriminatory act. Once an informal/formal complaint has begun, the complaint can be resolved at any stage of the process. All days are calendar days.



*INDIVIDUALS MAY ADD SIMULAR OR RELATED CLAIMS TO THEIR FORMAL COMPLAINT ANY TIME PRIOR TO THE CONCLUSION OF THE INVESTIGATION; **OR** AMENDMENTS CAN BE PURSUED VIA MOTION TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE JUDGE IF A HEARING HAS BEEN REQUESTED.

THE FLOW CHART ABOVE ILLUSTRATES THE COMPLAINT PROCESS. HOWEVER, IT DOES NOT COVER ALL THE NECESSARY DETAILS. FOR THESE DETAILS CONSULT THE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION (EEOC) OR NAVY DIRECTIVES. ALL TIMES REFERRED TOIN THE FLOW HART REPRESENT CALENDAR DAYS.
