What is WTP?

- CNO mandated program for Redeployers
- Designed to reduce deployment stress Take a deep breath
- Fulfill redeployment requirements (gear, weapons, PDHAs, workshops)
- Third Location Decompression
 - You come from Hi-Stress, Hi-Workload Environments
 - Work and family will have demands when you return
 - WTP is your time to Relax and Prepare for your return home
- Prepare for Reintegration: families, careers, communities, parent Command
- Venue to discuss your deployment with peers
- WTP has structured & unstructured elements with abundant free time
- What WTP is Not: Not R&R, Not Leave, Not demobilization processing
 We are here for YOU if you have a request while at WTP Ask!

Arrival in Germany



- •Upon your arrival to Germany, WTP Staff will greet you and provide transportation to Sembach. Transport time is 30 mins to 1 hour, depending on arrival location.
- •When you arrive at Sembach, you will drop off any gear you are returning. Staff will conduct a quick tour around Navy spaces and show you to your room.
- A welcome brief will commence upon the last Redeployers' arrival.



Things to Know



- Uniform policy
 - Civilian attire authorized on base and required off base; no U.S.A. or military pride off base; plan for seasonal cold & rain
 - Send home all but what you need for WTP and follow-on tasking; uniforms are required for rotator flights and processing at ECRC
